Since its foundation as a professional society in 1927, the Society has been dedicated to the promotion, support and nurturing of Geography, geographical research and education. The Society's membership is made up of Geography educators and researchers, practicing geographers and members of the public with broad interests in human and physical environments and travel.

What does the Geographical Society of New South Wales do?

The Society's mission is to represent Geography and geographers and to advance geographical scholarship in New South Wales and throughout Australia. It does this through a diversity of activities including:

Publication: The Society is responsible for Australia's oldest academic internationally respected Geography journal *Australian Geographer*. It also publishes four newsletters each year, and maintains a series of conference proceedings.

Support of geographical scholarship: The Society promotes the understanding and enjoyment of Geography through formal education, lectures to student and teacher conferences and the organisation of seminars and conferences presenting geographical research. The Society also supports Geography via the granting of prizes to undergraduates and awards to academics and other practitioners for contributions to Geography and for teaching excellence.

International study tours: The Society runs a yearly series of dynamic international study tours visiting a wide range of geographical regions. Recent tour itineraries have included Central America and Cuba, Wonders of South America and Across the Roof of the World to Ladakh.

Geographical information resources: The Society also maintains a library of written works, maps and geographical information resources in a collection held at the University of Sydney.

Policy input: Finally, the Society monitors and makes recommendations on policies and plans which will impact upon geographical research and teaching and which concern environmental and social issues in Australia.

What does membership of the Geographical Society of New South Wales offer?

Membership of the Society provides you with access to a programme of activities and a series of publications to support your interests in the societies and environments of Australia and its neighbouring regions. The Society's program of events is designed to meet the diversity of interests of its wide membership bases including travellers, educators, students and researchers. These events include academic conferences, travellers' club meetings, international study tours and award nights. As a member you will also receive three issues of *Australian Geographer* yearly, four issues of the Society's newsletter, and a regular up-date of the forthcoming Society events. Membership also entitles you to access the Society's library, which holds an extensive collection of geographical information resources.

If you are an educator, student, researcher or traveller with a particular interest in social and environmental issues, consider joining the Society. Members do not require specific qualifications. The Society welcomes the membership of all those interested in participating in its activities and supporting its aims.

How do I join the Geographical Society of New South Wales?

The Society does not require you to seek a proposer or seconder for your membership application. Upon receipt of this application, the Society will send you the most recent issue of the newsletter and your membership will proceed from there.
